## Week 1: Field Games Frenzy

June 2-4 \$105



Get ready to run, jump, laugh, and play as we kick off Summer Adventure Camps with a high-energy week of Field Games! Campers will dive into classic and creative team games while building sportsmanship, teamwork, and healthy active habits. Each day brings new challenges, group games, and plenty of chances to burn off energy. Games may include Capture the Flag, Four-Square, volleyball, basketball, and lots of camp-favorite surprises.

## Week 2: Girdwood Explorers: Flora, Fauna, and more.

June 8-12 \$105



Calling all Girdwood Explorers! This week, we are taking a closer look at the incredible natural world around us. Campers will explore local ecosystems by biking to the creek to search for macroinvertebrates, hiking through the forest to look for animal signs, and learning about native plants by creating a plant press. Expect hands-on discovery, outdoor games, and plenty of curiosity-driven adventures as we explore the wild wonders of Girdwood.

## Week 3: Adventures in Science

June 15-18 \$105



3...2...1...GO! Put on your thinking cap and get ready for a week full of curiosity, creativity, and discovery. Campers will explore the science behind motion, flight, and buoyancy through hands-on experiments and projects. We'll build and launch rockets, design and race boats in the stream, and test our ideas through trial and error. This week is all about asking questions, experimenting boldly, and learning through play.

## Week 4: Trail Blazers: An Iditarod Adventure

June 23-25 \$120



This week, campers will hike, bike, and explore the fascinating history of the Iditarod Trail! They'll step back in time with a visit to the historic Crow Creek Mine, try their hand at gold panning, and discover the unique geology of the area. Along the way, campers will learn about the vital role of sled dogs and mushers in Alaska's story. The week concludes with an unforgettable rafting adventure in Portage with Glacier City Rafting and Hiking.



## Week 5: Nature as Art

June 30 - July 2 \$115



Nature has inspired artists for centuries, and this week, it's our turn! Campers will explore the forest and use natural materials to create both take-home art projects and temporary nature art left behind for others to enjoy. We'll experiment with texture, color, and pattern, enjoy a painting lesson from a local artist, and finish the week by helping the Forest Fairies prepare for Forest Fair.

## Week 6: Outdoor Survival Skills

July 7-9 \$105

One of our most popular camps is back! Campers will learn practical outdoor skills to build confidence and preparedness for adventures big and small. We'll talk about what to do if you're lost, build personal safety kits, and learn the Rule of Threes. Campers will practice navigation through geocaching and compass work, and older students will safely learn fire-starting with flint and steel. The week concludes with a hands-on survival scenario featuring shelter building and teamwork.

## Week 7: Bike Skills

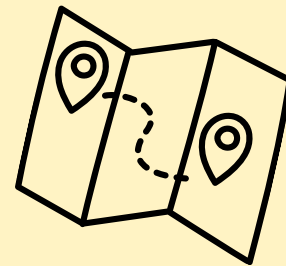
July 14-16 \$115
